Programs

Sessions at Caz are organized by age and musical ability. Basic instrumental requirements for each session are described in detail on our website. We want campers in each session to be challenged but not overwhelmed.

Individual Instruments: Strings, Winds, Brass, & Percussion

Musicians participate in one of three major ensembles: Orchestra, Concert Band, or Jazz Ensemble. Led by a new guest conductor each week, major ensembles rehearse two to three times a day for 60–90 minutes, preparing for their final performance. Jazz band participation is by audition only and limited to one week in the two-week sessions. Learn more about our major ensembles program on our website.

Piano

Piano is offered as a primary instrument in all sessions. The piano program includes individual coaching as well as participation in chamber ensembles. Our piano program fills up quickly so check availability when you register.

Guitar

The guitar program is primarily for acoustic guitar and is offered in the Middle School, Junior High, and High School sessions only. Campers receive individual coaching and perform solo and in chamber music ensembles.

World Beat Ensemble

No experience required! This exciting new program is available as a primary instrument choice in Young Musicians Session only. Students are taught rhythms and musical concepts using a variety of world instruments, percussion and ukulele. Curriculum can include repertoire in multiple languages, genres, and time periods. This will help prepare students for school ensembles throughout the year.
