

Cazadero Camper Conduct Contract

At Cazadero Music Camp we hold our staff and campers to a high standard of conduct. We are here to make music and have fun in a safe and respectful environment. Campers are responsible for their attitude, actions, and statements while at camp.

To make sure that everyone has a safe and wonderful experience, every camper must review and agree to our Good Citizen Expectations and Camp Rules. Please review this with your camper and send the initialed copy back to Caz by May 1, 2026.

Cazadero Music Camp Good Citizen Expectations:

- Abide by all of the camp's rules, policies, and procedures. [link to handbook/rules]
- Treat everyone with respect, dignity, and kindness.
- Bring a positive attitude to camp, live and play cooperatively, and help out when asked.
- Be honest and truthful with everyone and take responsibility for your actions and any mistakes.
- Respect all individuals' personal space and body at all times.
- Respect the privacy and property of others:
 - Never touch anyone else's personal belongings, especially instruments, without permission. This includes pianos and percussion instruments.
- Respect your campsite: do not litter or intentionally damage camp property, clean up after yourself whether you are inside or out.
- Follow dress code rules and wear closed-toe shoes at all times except for walking to the shower or swimming pool.
- Report any unsafe situations or injuries to a staff person immediately.
- Be on time to all meals and activities.

The following behaviors are not tolerated at Cazadero Music Camp and will result in disciplinary action. Items in bold will result in immediate dismissal from camp.

1. Harming other people, physically or emotionally. This includes fighting, threatening, teasing, insulting, and bullying.
2. Harassment toward anyone in the Cazadero Music Camp community including sexual behavior, statements, advances, or excessive displays of affection. Please review *Ensuring a Safe and Welcoming Environment* in our Camper Handbook for more information.
3. Putting yourself or others at risk. This includes unsafe choices, unsafe actions, and/or violating Camp Rules.
4. Harming the property of other people.
5. **Use or possession of any illegal or prohibited substances including alcohol, tobacco, or vaping paraphernalia.**
6. **Possession of a weapon of any kind.**
7. **Possession of fire starters of any kind including flint, fireworks, matches or lighters.**
8. **Theft and/or Vandalism**

Consequences – If a camper violates the Code of Conduct or any of the camp rules, they will have to take responsibility for their actions and the consequences. Depending on the situation, the parent(s)/guardian(s) may be notified. If necessary, the camper may be sent home without refund. Same day pick-up may be required.

Cazadero Music Camp reserves the right to send a camper home based upon a single unsafe, inappropriate, or illegal action.

Parent/Guardian:

I understand that my child is being held to a high standard of conduct, and that s/he may be sent home for unsafe, inappropriate, or illegal activities. If my child is sent home, I understand and agree that I will be responsible for his/her transportation home, and I will not receive a refund. I have reviewed these rules with my child prior to camp.
